

Working Together for the Renovation & Expansion of the Hopkinton Public Library

Hopkinton Public Library Foundation

A 501(c)(3) non-profit organization raising private funds for the expansion and state-of-the-art renovation of the Library. In addition to the \$4.5 million grant awarded by the Massachusetts Board of Library Commissioners, private funds raised by HPLF will defray the Town's cost of restoring, renovating and expanding the Library's historic building.

Hopkinton Public Library Board of Trustees

A five-member elected board responsible for overseeing the Library for the benefit of the community. Working closely with the Library Director, members are responsible for establishing Library policies and plans, determining the final budget, and conducting public relations.

Hopkinton Public Library

Led by the Library Director, and within the Town government, strives to be a comfortable, welcoming central place for the community which is accessible to all; provide access to a variety of materials, services and programs to enhance educational, cultural, social, and intellectual endeavors and to extend personal growth and development.

Friends of the Hopkinton Public Library

A nonprofit, membership organization that generously supports the immediate needs of the Library through hands-on volunteerism and activities (used-book sales and apple crisp sale at PolyArts) to fund purchases such as media equipment, shelving, and museum passes.

Hopkinton Public Library Building Committee

Permanent Building Committee (PBC) comprised of 5 members was appointed by the Selectmen to serve all Hopkinton facilities projects. An additional 3 Temporary Members were appointed to the PBC for the Library project, and serve for the life of the expansion/renovation project. Since 2010, this joint entity has worked diligently with Johnson Roberts Architects, the Massachusetts Board of Library Commissioners, and countless other Town boards and committees to advance the Library building project.
